

Proposed Sale at Sanders Street, Korumburra

South Gippsland Shire Council proposes to sell Council land on the corner of Sanders Street and the South Gippsland Highway, Korumburra.

Council has received a planning permit application for the development of a service station at 8220 South Gippsland Highway, Korumburra and a request to purchase the adjoining portion of Council land.

The land is not required for any Council purposes and has been assessed as suitable for inclusion in the development.

Council's Manager Sustainable Communities Chris Van Der Ark advised that while the land had been designated for a tree reserve it had never been used for that purpose. "At the moment the piece of land is something of an anomaly. Council envisages that selling the land may assist with the future development of a prime commercial site in Korumburra."

Council is undertaking public consultation in regards to the land sale and will accept written submissions from the community until 5.00pm on 18 January 2017.

All feedback received will be considered at the next available Council meeting where submitters will have the opportunity to speak to their submission if requested.

If no submissions are received Council will proceed with the sale of the land.
