

Road discontinuance in Fish Creek

Council has commenced the statutory procedures to remove the road status from an unused portion of road reserve in Fish Creek with the intention of selling the land to the adjoining landowner.

Written submissions are invited from the public to the proposal in accordance with Section 223 of the Local Government Act.

Council received a request from the landowner to purchase part of the unused road reserve being part of Williamson Street, Fish Creek, to use and develop the land with a dwelling and develop land with an agricultural shed.

Manager Sustainable Communities, Chris Van Der Ark, confirmed the road was unused, unmade, not on Council's Public Road Register and not considered to be required for its original purpose as a road in the future.

Council will hear and consider any submissions before determining an outcome and land owners within the immediate vicinity of the road to be discontinued and sold will be notified.

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
