



Public Place Recycling for Mirboo North and Mossvale Park

Residents and visitors are able to make sustainable choices when disposing of their litter in Mirboo North and at Mossvale Park now that South Gippsland Shire Council has completed a public litter bin upgrade.

Materials that can be put in the new public place recycling bins include glass bottles and jars, rigid plastic bottles and containers, aluminium cans and items made from paper and cardboard, including disposable coffee cups.

The project was sponsored by the Keep Australia Beautiful Beverage Container Recycling Community Grants, funded by Coca-Cola.

Council's Waste Management Supervisor Pete Roberts was pleased the new service could be offered in Mirboo North.

"This new service will help to reduce the amount of litter and waste sent to landfill each year and increase the recovery of recyclable packaging materials.

"Council would like to encourage our residents and visitors to use the service to its full potential by recycling as much as possible," said Mr Roberts.

Similar projects implemented in Leongatha in 2016 and in Korumburra in 2014 have been a great success.

These projects are consistent with the aims and objectives of Council's Waste Management Strategy which supports projects that reduce waste sent to landfill and recover recyclable materials.
