

Congratulations to Community Grants Winners

South Gippsland Shire Council wishes to congratulate successful applicants for Round Two of the 2016/17 Community Grants Program.

Thirty eight successful applicants were acknowledged at an awards ceremony yesterday with \$188,140 awarded to community groups across South Gippsland.

Successful applicants were awarded under the categories of Minor Projects and Equipment; Celebrations, Festivals and Events; Major Projects and Planning and Development Studies including successful applications to the small Emergency Grants and Dairy Tight Times Support Events programs.

Council has now allocated almost \$300,000 to more than 90 projects through the Community Grants Program in 2016/17.

South Gippsland Shire Mayor Councillor Ray Argento wished to congratulate each successful community group for their applications.

"Congratulations to all the community groups who were successful in receiving funding in what was a competitive pool of applications this year.
