

Proposal for unnamed road

Four properties lining an unnamed road off the South Gippsland Highway, Leongatha have been causing confusion for the public and emergency services.

Currently the properties are addressed to the South Gippsland Highway, when in reality they should belong to the unnamed road.

South Gippsland Shire Council has since moved forward with the request for a new road name, with Avery Lane passing the required compliancy checks.

The suggested name would be in recognition of local Harry Avery, a local butcher who owned the land of the old 'Drive In' adjacent to the unnamed road, following approval from the local historical society and affected property owners.

Close consultation using surveys and consideration for the affected property owners was undertaken.

South Gippsland Mayor Councillor Lorraine Brunt said that the project was a perfect opportunity for the community to put forward any suggestions and work collaboratively with Council.

“Public safety is paramount. This unnamed road will be officially named and registered, thus ensuring emergency services can locate all properties on this road.

“There were no objections received in response to the public notice,” said the Mayor.
