

Final Preparations for Sustainability Festival

South Gippsland Shire Council and Bass Coast Shire Council are completing final preparations for the Southern Gippsland Sustainability Festival being held next week.

All are welcome to attend the free event at the Coal Creek Community Park and Museum carpark from 10.00am to 3.00pm on 3 April 2016.
