

Weymes Road Proposed Opening

Weymes Road, Mount Eccles is proposed to be formally opened to avoid rendering an adjoining property as landlocked following Council's meeting yesterday.

The land upon which Weymes Road has been established is owned by Council as a lot on title. This being the case, it renders the adjoining land owner's land as landlocked on title unless the legal status is changed to 'Road' status. This situation is an anomaly which Council can easily rectify using its powers under the *Local Government Act, 1989*.

Community members will have the opportunity to have their say in regards to the proposal by making a submission to Council during consultation.

Council will open a public consultation process from 30 November 2016 to 5.00pm on 4 January 2017 where written submissions will be accepted.

More information will be provided about the public consultation process in Council's Noticeboard in local papers.

All submissions received will be heard and reviewed at the next available Council meeting before a final decision is determined.

If no submissions are received the road will be declared open and published in the Victorian Government Gazette.
