

Road discontinuance in Allambee

Three parcels of unused roads in Allambee are proposed to be sold to the adjoining landowner and consolidated into the one property.

These include two portions of unused government road (the former Mirboo-Yarragon Road), which are no longer required for the purposes of a road and can be discontinued and sold by the State Government.

In between these two parcels of unused government road is a parcel of Council road reserve that is also no longer required as a road.

Council must first formally discontinue the Subject Land so that it can also be sold to the adjoining landowner.

Written submissions from the public are invited in order for Council to formally discontinue each road.
