

Next Steps for Korumburra Outdoor Pool

The Korumburra Outdoor Pool is set to progress to detailed design following South Gippsland Shire Council's endorsement of the masterplan yesterday.

Council has allocated significant funds in its future budgets to deliver the outcomes of the masterplan.

The masterplan was completed with a range of community feedback sourced through meetings with the Korumburra Swimming Club and further distribution through local newspapers, Council's website and social media.

The development of the masterplan provides direction and the ability to continue planning for the identified capital works.

The completion of the masterplan allows for the commencement of the detailed design process which is subject to future budget allocations.

South Gippsland Shire Council's Director Sustainable Communities and Infrastructure Anthony Seabrook was pleased the masterplan was finalised.

"We would like to thank the Korumburra Swimming Club and users of the pool for providing their positive feedback for the masterplan.

"Users of the Korumburra outdoor pool strongly supported the masterplan developed for the site so no changes were necessary.

"They are hoping to see the project continue into the design phase and be allocated funding for this in a future Capital Works Program," said Mr Seabrook.
