

Council Adopts 2017/18 Annual Budget

South Gippsland Shire Council adopted the 2017/18 Annual budget at its meeting yesterday, finalising months of deliberation.

Final projections for next financial year are now complete, resulting in a total budgeted expenditure of \$63.9 million as well as expenditure on a capital works program of \$22.7 million.

The 2017/18 Capital Works Program is \$2.3 million higher than allocated in 2016/17 and significantly higher than recent previous financial years.

Sixty-seven written submissions were received and considered from the Proposed Budget in May as part of the budget exhibition process.

As part of this consideration, Council passed an amendment to receive a report on how it could reduce staff costs to 2016/17 levels.

South Gippsland Shire Mayor Councillor Ray Argento wanted to congratulate all involved in producing the budget.

"Council is extremely proud to finalise a budget that includes a capital works program worth over \$20 million.

"This is a major achievement in a rate capped environment, it is required to ensure our community has vital infrastructure for the liveability of South Gippsland.

"Congratulations are in order for my fellow councillors and our staff for producing a financially stable budget and thank you to our residents who considered the budget and made submissions," said the Mayor.
