Proposed New Road Name Leongatha



South Gippsland Shire Council is proposing to name a road in the locality of Leongatha. The location and extent of the road proposed to be named is detailed below:




Figure 1 - Locality Map

This unnamed road traverses to the East off South Gippsland Hwy, Leongatha for approximately 355 metres (shown as **Edition** in **Figure 1**) and is on Councils Public Road Registrar as a public road.

ORIGIN OF ROAD NAME

AVERY – after Harry Avery who had a small butchers shop in McCartin Street, Leongatha in the 1940's and 1950's. The Avery's also owned the land adjacent to the unnamed road on the north side and later on in the 1960's becoming the site for the Leongatha "Drive-In".
