

Proposal for Unnamed Road in Koonwarra

Three properties abutting an unnamed road outside of Koonwarra have been causing confusion for the general public, transport vehicles and emergency services.

Currently all three properties are addressed to Caithness Road, Koonwarra when in reality they should be addressed to this unnamed road.

South Gippsland Shire Council has moved forward with the request from landowners for a new road name, with Dashan Lane passing the required compliance checks.

Council utilised voting polls for residents which allowed for a clear and distinct favourite. Upon the decision, the proposal will now be sent forward to the Registrar of Geographic Place Names for final consideration and approval.

Subject to the approval, notification will be given to the affected landowners and public.

South Gippsland Mayor Councillor Lorraine Brunt has spoken about the importance of good communication between Council and the affected residents.

“Public safety is of utmost importance. Naming this road will thus ensure the safety of the residents and allow emergency services access.

“There were few objections received in response to the voting on the residents behalf, Council is happy with the final outcome,” said the Mayor.
