

Walkerville Foreshore Improvement Works

This week significant improvement works will commence along the foreshore at Walkerville North.

Council's contractor is expecting the works begin on 26 February following the completion of the rock seawall.

Funding for the project has been provided by South Gippsland Shire Council and the Walkerville Foreshore Reserve Committee of Management.

The improvement works will include road and drainage upgrades, retaining walls as well as car and boat trailer parking.

The project also includes the addition of new footpaths and speed management to provide a safer environment for both vehicles and pedestrian traffic.

Council would like to advise that there will be delays to traffic during the works.

John Moylan, Council's Manager of Infrastructure & Projects, has expressed the importance of the works for the community.

"We're very pleased to see these important works proceeding now that the summer peak is over.

"We expect the works will enhance the beautiful surrounds and make the area more accessible for visitors and locals," said Mr. Moylan.
