

Sealed Road Capital Works Underway

As part of its \$2.1 million Pavement Rehabilitation Program Council has commenced working on four sealed roads to repair, strengthen and improve the quality of the road surface.

The road treatment process utilises existing pavement gravel and rock with the addition of some rock and cement for stabilising.

There will be some delays during this time. If possible motorists should seek alternative routes until the works are complete.

The works in question will be completed in the following order:

- 650 metres of Grip Road, Toora west from Lawsons Road.
- 1.5 kilometres of Patersons Road, Nyora between Lang Lang/Poowong Road and Berrys Road.
- 115 metres of Hawkins Street, Korumburra from Jumbunna Road.
- 1.0 kilometres of Mt Eccles Road, Mt Eccles north of Amietts Road.

South Gippsland Shire Council's Coordinator of Engineering, Paul Challis emphasised the importance of the works.

"Council appreciates the patience of community members while we undertake this series of upgrades to ensure the safety of motorists.

"The Pavement Rehabilitation Program will benefit the community greatly and help strengthen and reinforce of our roads allowing for less interruptions to motorist's journeys in future," said Mr Challis.
