

Adoption of Council Plan

This week Council adopted the revised Council Plan 2017-2021 following the consideration and determination of submissions made at a Special Meeting of Council on 30 May 2018.

The revised Council Plan 2017-2021 includes the relocation of strategies to better align to the outcomes they seek to achieve, three additional strategies have also been included;

- Undertake a coastal study to explore opportunities for developing the Shire's coastal areas, while still protecting the coastline environment.
- Review and update recreation, aquatic and the paths and trails strategies
- Develop and implement a Youth Strategy to determine the needs of young people and assist them to have a voice regarding matters that affect them.

Council has considered community feedback and Councillors' ideas received through a range of mediums in the revision of the Council Plan.

A copy of the adopted Council Plan will be provided to the Minister for Local Government in accordance with the Local Government *Act*. It is also available on Council's website and all South Gippsland Libraries.

South Gippsland Shire Council Mayor, Councillor Lorraine Brunt thanked the community for their participation during the review process.

"Council appreciates the concerns and submissions that were taken into account whilst we revised the Council Plan.

"After twelve months, I think we have started setting the foundations for our success. We hope to achieve our Vision and continue to work with the community to accomplish the strategies," said the Mayor.

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
