



Municipal Emergency Management Plan Endorsed

South Gippsland Shire Council has adopted the South Gippsland Municipal Emergency Management Plan 2018-2021.

The plan has been developed in collaboration with all emergency services and organisations represented on the South Gippsland Municipal Emergency Management Planning Committee.

The plan formalises a collaborative multi-agency response and recovery to emergencies in South Gippsland and will ensure the Municipal Emergency Management Planning Committee complies with the requirements of the Emergency Management Manual of Victoria and the committee audit process.

The plan details the agreed arrangements for the prevention, response and recovery from a range of emergencies that could potentially occur in the region.

Council was notified last week of the successful audit of the plan and the committee was congratulated for its commitment to emergency management and the safety of its community.

South Gippsland Shire Council Mayor, Councillor Lorraine Brunt was happy to adopt the Municipal Emergency Management Plan.

“With this adoption we can continue the safety of our towns and address the consequences of a natural disaster.

“Working with multiple emergency services, government organisations, businesses and the community ensures the Municipal Emergency Management Plan will be effective in our municipality,” said the Mayor.
