

Korumburra Soccer Club Changeroom upgrade

On Wednesday the Korumburra Recreation Reserve Changeroom Redevelopment was officially opened. The project cost \$380,000, which included a \$250,000 contribution from the Victorian Government's World Game Facilities Fund 2018. The works included the redevelopment of the existing changeroom facilities to provide accessible and female friendly athlete and umpire changerrooms and amenities.

This project will provide the 104 members of the Korumburra Soccer Club with further training opportunities, while also providing greater flexibility for future use of the facility.

The project scope was for the development of:

- Two changerrooms each with two showers and two toilets including one ambulant toilet
- An umpires' changerroom with two separate cubicles that each have a shower and toilet
- All all-person toilet and shower with a baby changerroom
- Female and male public amenities which are separate to the changerrooms.

The upgrade will complement the increase in soccer participation across the municipality, particularly the significant increase in female participation. The Korumburra City Soccer Club was established in 2007 and has seen considerable growth since then. The Gippsland Soccer League also utilises this facility for its highly successful Skills Acquisition Program, Country Championship trials and training and annual Korumburra pre-season cup.

The Korumburra Soccer Club has a focus on inclusion and growth in the future and Council and Gippsland Soccer League strongly support them in this.
