The Victorian Government has banned all items with a cord, battery or plug from landfill. This could be a whole range of items from work, home or even the garden shed - from old phones, computers and household appliance to power tools and toys.

When you consider what is inside e-waste and that up to 90 per cent of it can be recovered and made into something else, it makes no sense to bury electronic objects in the ground once we are finished with them.

E-waste will be accepted at Council's Transfer Stations (tips) to be recycled.
