INCLUDED WORKS:

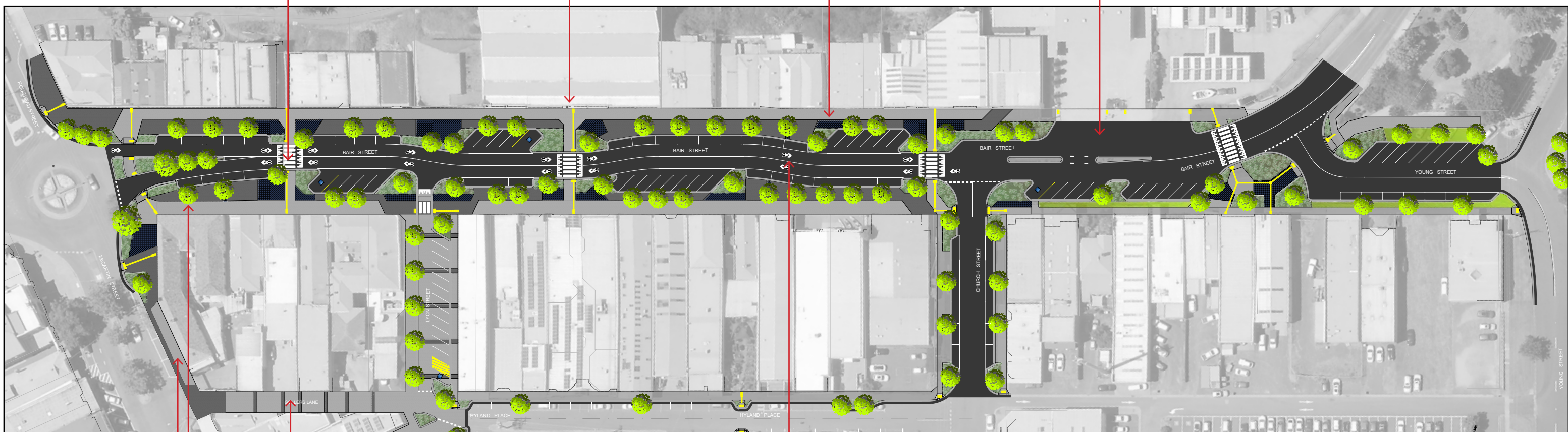
- Water main and service line renewals by SG Water

- New energy efficient street lighting
- Replacement and improvements of drainage network
- Accessibility improvements
- New bins, seats and bike racks
- Telecommunications pits renewal
- Road pavement renewal
