

Annual Report Released

South Gippsland Shire Council recognised the outcomes from the last financial year and endorsed the Draft 2018/19 Annual Report at its meeting this week.

The Annual Report provides a detailed account of Council's achievements, challenges and performance measures for the 2018/19 financial year.

The report opens with a snapshot of achievements that Council completed in the last twelve months that align with the Council Plan.

The report also highlights that \$8.1 million was spent on infrastructure over the last year which included \$4.2 million on road management, \$1.6 million on bridge management and \$439,000 on footpath development.

South Gippsland Shire Council's Acting Chair of the Panel of Administrators Christian Zahra AM recognised the challenges faced as a Council over the last year and was optimistic for the future.

"The 2018/19 Annual Report provides a detailed outline of our challenges and achievements for the last financial year. It's a snapshot and a useful document to understand what Council has been doing.

"Everyone who has an interest in Council's operations are encouraged to view this document to improve their understanding," Mr Zahra AM.
