Council's L2P Leaner Driver Mentor Program has once again assisted a young learner obtain their licence.

Olivia joined the program in late 2018 and has been gaining experience with her volunteer mentor Bill. Bill is an experienced driver and has provided Olivia with a great starting point for her to become independent and reach her goals.

Their driving adventures have seen them travel over 6,000 kilometres to many different towns and Melbourne through sunshine, rain, hail and the dreaded cross winds.

Olivia felt very confident on the day of her driving test and believed this is because of her mentor Bill and his guidance.

The L2P Learner Driver Mentor Program helps young people who do not have a supervising driver or cannot access a car to complete the required 120 hours of supervised driving experience.

Each mentor is a volunteer that provides their time to assist young people in our community. Mentors are required to attend three training sessions, hold a full Victorian Drivers Licence and conduct other relevant checks.

While the Local Law Amendment would have introduced a fine to support the cat curfew, the curfew itself is still in place. There is no requirement for cats to be kept inside 24 hours a day, however cats must remain on their owner's property.

With the proposed Local Law Amendment recently being

discontinued Council will continue with its current

practices in relation to the containment of cats.

If your cat is found outside your property boundaries it may be impounded and a release fee will be required to retrieve it from the pound. As the Local Law Amendment did not proceed, a fine will not be imposed.
