

South Gippsland Shire Council News Additional Green Waste Amnesty Now On!

Council has implemented an additional green waste amnesty from now until 10 March.

The additional amnesty was a matter considered by our Administrators in early February and was put in place to help reduce fire-risks on private property.

During the amnesty residents can dispose of their green waste for free at any of Council's transfer stations. There are some species that cannot be included as part of the amnesty such as blackberry, ragwort, broom, mirror bush, kikuyu grass, hawthorn, cape weed, gorse, pampas grass, palm fronds, cordylines, yuccas and related species
