Positive Local Economic Outcomes

Recently Council's Economic Development and Tourism team briefed Council and the public on the economic status of the region.

Some of the stand-out statistics included:

- An overall economic output of \$3.5 billion
- A total of 11,157 jobs in South Gippsland
- There is an unemployment rate of 2.2 per cent. Which is lower than the Victorian average (4.7 per cent)

- Our top three towns for economic output is Leongatha (\$1.219 billion), Korumburra (\$549 million) and Foster (\$241 million)
- Our top three industries for economic output are Agriculture, Forestry and Fishing (\$717 million), Manufacturing (\$670 million) and Construction (\$392 million)
