



Korumburra Town Centre Streetscape Redevelopment

Background

The Korumburra Town Centre Streetscape Redevelopment project is for traffic and pedestrian safety enhancements and includes improvements to the town's visual appeal and functionality along Commercial Street from Bridge Street to King Street. The proposed changes to traffic movement and parking can be implemented with minimal disruption to existing infrastructure.

Vision

The vision of the Korumburra Town Centre Streetscape Redevelopment is a town centre that integrates a safe and functional road reconfiguration with multiple public realm improvements.

This will provide physical structure necessary to achieve the main project goal of revitalising Korumburra's town centre.

Benefits

- Improving the appearance of the town centre through landscape interventions such as avenue planting and improved footpath conditions
- Improving the safety and functionality of Commercial Street and key intersections
- Improving the accessibility of the town centre to visitors with a change in parking configuration, increased connectivity to stopping areas and a proposed signage overhaul
- Providing a series of new public open spaces which increase activity in the town centre
- Improving connectivity to areas near Commercial Street in the town centre
- Minimising the impact on existing infrastructure to increase the likelihood of future implementation by reducing costs and minimising disruption during construction

Our Next Steps

Our Request

Council requires \$1.75 million from other levels of government to complete the project

Government funding will be required for the various elements of the Korumburra Revitalising Project as Council seeks to enhance the main streets and business precincts of its larger towns through urban design projects.

Detailed designs for the Korumburra Town Centre Streetscape Redevelopment will be completed mid 2020 and therefore ready for construction once funding is secured.

The total project cost is \$3.5 million which Council has committed \$1.75 million.

Korumburra Revitalisation Project

The Korumburra Town Centre Streetscape Redevelopment is a component of the Korumburra Revitalisation Project. The project will reinvigorate the town centre to meet community needs through development of integrated services.

A number of benefits will be experienced by the South Gippsland community including:

- Town investment with new and expanding businesses providing economic growth and new employment opportunities
- Image and identity enhancement of Korumburra
- Sustainable transport options for the town centre with clear pedestrian access and movement
- Upgraded amenities in the CBD including roads, footpaths, landscaping and street furniture
- A precinct within the grounds of the railway station which will bring together various community services and open space activities
