The next stage of the Bair Street Redevelopment Project will begin soon. The first stage, which was coordinated by South Gippsland Water, involved the replacement of old water mains along the length of Bair Street.

The next stage - due to start at the end of March - will include the relocation of overhead powerlines underground. This significant undertaking will allow for a cleaner streetscape and create more opportunities for footpath trading and dining. Civil works to improve the footpath and reduce the lanes from four to two will follow soon after.
