



Coal Creek Easter Egg Hunt Cancelled

Coal Creek Community Park and Museum's annual Easter Egg Hunt has been cancelled following advice from health authorities to limit non-essential, organised gatherings of 500 or more people. The event which was scheduled for Easter Sunday is an annual event which traditionally attracts large crowds.

Coal Creek Community Park and Museum Coordinator, Rowena Ashley has mixed feelings about the cancellation.

"Although we are sad that the event is unable to proceed this year, it is more important that we follow the advice of health authorities to help protect our community. We expect the event to be back next year, bigger and better than ever," said Ms. Ashley.

Anyone who has already purchased tickets for the event is eligible for a refund. Tickets purchased at Coal Creek can be refunded at the venue upon proof of purchase. Tickets purchased online will be refunded onto the credit card used in the transaction.
