South Gippsland Shire Council News Changes to Our Immunisation Schedule

Due to the COVID-19 outbreak our usual immunisation schedule has been disrupted.

In order to still provide our community with this essential service one Shire-wide session will be held this month as follows.

Wednesday 8 April
Memorial Hall, McCartin Street,
Leongatha (laneway entrance)
9.30am to 12.30pm

No appointments will be necessary for this session.

This session will be run differently in order to keep our community and staff safe including:

- Only one parent/carer will be allowed to be present with their child for the session.

- A COVID-19 checklist and temperature checks (with a no-touch instrument) will be required on arrival.
- Only two people (and their children) will be allowed into the hall at one time. Those waiting will be required to wait outside while practicing social distancing.
- Those wishing to provide their mobile numbers on check-in may leave the site and will be contacted when it is their turn.
- Complete sterilisation of immunisation stations will occur after each patient is seen. This will cause delays and we appreciate everyone's patience at this time.

Future immunisation sessions will be revised as the circumstances continue to evolve and community updates will be provided.

BOAT RAMPS CLOSED

Please be advised that boat ramps in South Gippsland are now closed to all but the Coast Guard and commercial fishers. According to Victorian Government guidelines recreational boating and fishing are considered non-essential. As such anyone using a boat for recreation can be fined more than \$1600.

The advice from Maritime Safety Victoria is to stay home, take the time to inspect your lifejackets and keep on top of boat maintenance, and prepare for when we have the all clear to head back out.

CLOSURE OF OUTDOOR PUBLIC FACILITIES

All of South Gippsland Shire's playgrounds, skateparks, BBQs and water fountains are closed until further notice.

Please note at this stage public toilets remain open for use and parks are still available for those getting their essential exercise where the social distancing measures are being adhered to.
