

Proposed Council Plan 2020-2024 Ready for Comment

South Gippsland Shire Council endorsed the Proposed Council Plan 2020-2024 at its meeting yesterday which will now be available for the community to make comment.

The Council Plan is fundamental to Council's function as it determines the priorities and actions required over the next four years which are supported by the Council Budget.

Council determined that it was appropriate to create a new four-year Council Plan to guide the Administrators' term and the commencement of the new Council's term, to be elected in October 2021.

The proposed plan incorporates four key objectives for implementation including:

- United Shire: share community direction
- Economic Prosperity: corner stone for local employment and business growth
- Integrated Services and Infrastructure: enhance liveability
- Customer Focused Organisation: accountable decision making

Each of these objectives aims to help South Gippsland prosper while ensuring that Council provides a high level of service to the community.

South Gippsland Shire's Chair Administrator, Ms Julie Eisenbise was proud to present the Proposed Council Plan 2020-2024 to the community.

"I would like to thank Council staff and my fellow Administrators for all their work so far on the Council Plan and for making it possible to release to the community for their review.

"This is an important step in development of the Council Plan as our actions have implications for the community. We want to ensure that the Council Plan balances community needs and our ability to provide services," said Ms Eisenbise.
