Out of the many changes from these restrictions both playgrounds and skateparks have now been re-opened!

We've able to undertake repairs and maintenance of our playgrounds during the closure period and install new play equipment in Pandora Avenue, Venus Bay; Eccles Way, Leongatha; Sunnyside Park, Loch and Station Road, Foster.

Council is proud to provide these facilities for our local community - it's rewarding to see areas that create joy and are often used by families and friends as spaces for connection.

There are still some considerations you should take when using community play spaces - remember people should not gather in groups of more than 20 and stay 1.5 metres apart from others where possible.

The below is an update of Council's operations following the Premier's announcement to slowly relax restrictions:

- Our parks and recreation reserves will be open for exercise subject to social distancing.
- Our playgrounds and skateparks are open, with a maximum of 20 people allowed to use equipment at any one time. Physical distancing and gathering rules apply at all times.
- Men's Sheds can re-open and arts/crafts gatherings can resume as long as they are kept to 20 people or fewer and the four square metre rule is adhered to.
- Our boat ramps are open.
- Further details will come for our caravan parks and Coal Creek Community Park and Museum.
