Are You Fire Ready?

Fire season is almost upon us. To get our community ready, Council is providing a Green Waste Amnesty period that concludes on 31 December 2020.

Within the amnesty period, residents can dispose of their green waste for free at any of Council's transfer stations.

Council is offering this service to assist residents to remove potential fire hazards on their properties.

Hazard reduction is not a new concept to many of us, but it is a vital step to keep us and our community safe.

There are some species of plants that are not included during this amnesty period. If a species is not included, they must be disposed of in general waste and the applicable disposal fees paid. Some of the species not included are Blackberry, Ragwort and Cape Weed species.
