

Final Payment to Recreation Reserves under the Community Support Package

South Gippsland Shire Council will this week send off the final round of payments to recreation reserves under the \$2 million COVID-19 Community Support Package.

The \$2 million COVID-19 Community Support Package offered funding to support community and not-for-profit organisations operating in South Gippsland. At the October Council meeting, a portion of this fund was allocated to the volunteer recreation reserves within the municipality in recognition of the challenges being faced by committees and clubs with the cancellation of activities due to COVID-19.

Twenty of our local recreation reserves have been allocated funding under the package, a welcome relief after a tough year for many. A feature of the program was to ensure the money flowed quickly to reserves to help the committees, clubs and community to resume normal activities.

With this final payment, that brings the total amount of funds paid to recreation reserves from Council to \$377,000 this financial year. These funds help reserve volunteers and clubs to maintain their facilities that are utilised by so many people in the community.
