UPCOMING ROAD CLOSURE AND NIGHT WORKS - BAIR STREET LEONGATHA

From Monday 18 January to Friday 22 January 2021 (weather dependent), the full length of Bair Street will be closed to traffic for night works.

These works will be for road pavement. The street will be reopened daily during business hours, but there will be changes to road conditions and delays to traffic. Detours will be in place during the road closure. Through traffic will be required to see alternate routes.
