The Christmas/New Year break saw some great tourism numbers flow through our Shire, taking advantage of our beautiful scenery and local eateries.

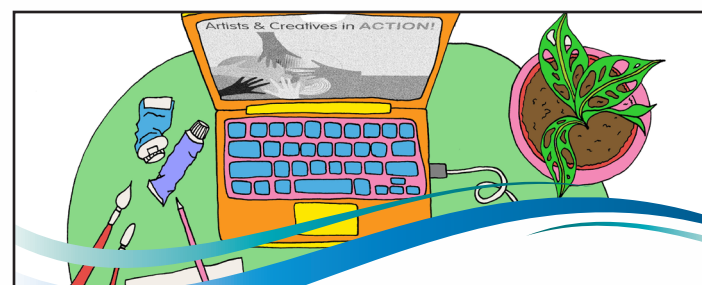
At South Gippsland Shire Council, we have heard some great hospitality business stories, like the Riverview Hotel in Tarwin Lower. The historic
