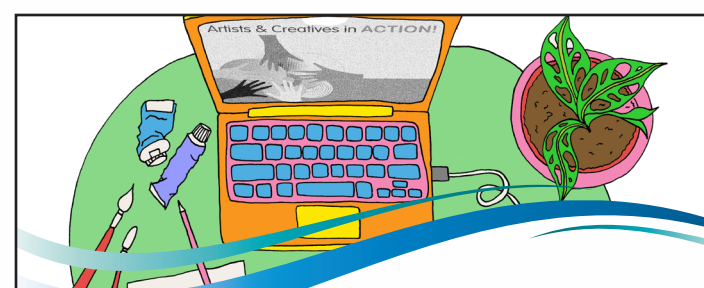
She has a shared love of farming
