

Community Grant Applications are now open!

The second round of Council's 2020/21 Community Grants Program is open and accepting applications until the end of March.

The first round of the program for this financial year closed back in August last year and allowed Council to better support community initiatives that enhance the quality of life, heritage, recreation and cultural opportunities for South Gippsland residents.

There are four different grants that can be applied for by your organisation or community group. They include:

- Minor Projects and Equipment: Between \$1,000 \$5,000
- Major Projects and Equipment: Between \$5,000 \$10,000
- Planning and Development Reports: Between \$5,000 \$10,000
- Festivals and Events: Between \$1,000 \$10,000
