Extension work begins for Great Southern Rail Trail

The Great Southern Rail Trail extension has kicked off this week with the sod turning ceremony.

This extension will see the rail trail reach from Leongatha to Nyora, adding a whopping 36 kilometres to the trail. Once complete, the rail trail will be over 100 kilometres long.


The work has been made possible by funding from Sport and Recreation Victoria, Regional Development Victoria and South Gippsland Shire Council.
