

South Gippsland Shire Council News **Community Grants open for submission**

The second round of Council's 2020/21 Community Grants Program is open and accepting applications until the end of March.

The first round, which was open from July to August 2020, saw a number of local community organisations receive funding to upgrade their equipment or get a start on some outstanding projects.

Local groups and organisations that receive funding such as community grants are not the only ones who benefit. Often the positive outcomes of new projects and/or equipment impact whole communities for the better.

There are four grants that can be applied for by organisations or community groups. They are:

- Minor Projects and Equipment: Between \$1,000 to \$5,000
- Major Projects and Equipment: Between \$5,000 to \$10,000
- Planning and Development Reports: Between \$5,000 to \$10,000
- Festivals and Events: Between \$1,000 to \$10,000
