The TAC L2P Learner Driver Program is a statewide initiative designed to help disadvantaged young people aged between 16 and 21 gain driving experience and set them up to get their driving licence.

We have a number of young people who are on the list who need an experienced driver to teach them how to drive.

To become an L2P mentor you need:

To attend three training sessions

- To hold a full Victorian Drivers • Licence
- A willingness to work with young people
- Minimum 10 years driving experience (preferred but not essential)


