

South Gippsland Shire Council News Writers are in the Libraries


Five local writers have been selected and are undertaking their one-month residency across four of our libraries.

Jenny Taylor, Jillian Durance, CS Hughes, John Tebbutt and the Loch Writers Group have all been tasked with completing either a poem, short story, essay or song that responds to the themes of isolation, emergence and connection.

The program is part of South Gippsland Shire Council's \$2M COVID-19 Community Support Package that aims to assist our regions recovery post the COVID-19 pandemic. As part of this package, \$252,000 has been allocated to ten creative projects. Through this investment, it is hoped that the profile of arts and culture in South Gippsland will be raised through a diverse range of events, workshops and activities.
