The new community hub in Korumburra, known currently as the Korumburra Hub, is looking for a name prior to building commencement.

When it comes to choosing a name for something as important as this new hub community input is essential, so we are calling on all of you to have your say.

Having a name may not seem important, but it is needed for public safety. The unique name will help make the space easily recognisable by emergency services and members of the public and will be registered with Geographic Names Victoria so everyone can find it easily.

There aren't too many rules for the name, but it does need to be related to Korumburra, it's people and culture, Traditional Owner heritage, local flora and fauna, Australian War contribution or something simple like the current temporary name.

Once the hub has been built, it will be home to the library, Milpara Community House and other community groups.
