

Proposed 2021/22 Council Budget and Financial Plan Ready to Review

South Gippsland Shire Council endorsed the Proposed 2021/22 Council Budget and Proposed 2021/22 to 2030/31 Financial Plan at its meeting yesterday which has now been released for community comment.

The Council Budget and Financial Plan are fundamental for Council's function as they outline how it will fund future operations. At its core, the Council Budget notes Council's aspirations for the next four financial years – how it intends to serve our community and deliver services and capital works.

In the Budget, Council is adhering to the 1.5 per cent rate increase in line with the cap set by the Victorian Government under the Fair Go Rates System. We believe that investing in our community is vitally important as we assess the impacts of COVID-19 and move forward.

The 2021/22 Budget is one part of the 2021/22 to 2024/25 budget and includes a range of exciting priorities for this financial year, including:

- Welcoming and onboarding South Gippsland's newly elected Councillors.
- Working in partnership with the community to develop a new Vision for South Gippsland.
- \$4.839M for the Korumburra Hub project.
- \$4.275M for the Great Southern Rail Trail.
- \$3.512M for the redevelopment of the Little Commercial Street Streetscape in Korumburra.
- The Bair Street streetscape works will be finalised.
- \$1.1M for the Leongatha Railway Site Transformation project, which includes a
 pedestrian bridge to provide access to and from Bair Street and improvements to the
 Apex Park car park.
- \$600,000 for the Korumburra Railway Precinct project.
- Commencement of investigation and consultation into the future uses of Memorial Hall in response to the outcomes of the revised Arts Strategy.

The overall Capital Works program for 2021/22 totals \$39.223M, which includes \$1.756M of projects that have been carried forward from 2020/21.
