Budget 2021/22 ready for review

At South Gippsland Shire Council's meeting on 14 April, Administrators endorsed the Proposed 2021/22 Council Budget and the Proposed 2021/22 to 2030/31 Financial Plan.

The Council Budget and Financial Plan are fundamental to Council's function as they outline how future operations will be funded. At it's core, the Budget outlines Council's aspirations for the next four financial years - how it intends to serve the community and deliver services and capital works.

The 2021/22 Council Budget is just one part of the 2021/22 to 2024/25 budget and includes a number of exciting

priorities for this financial year such as the Korumburra Hub project, Great Southern Rail Trail extension and the redevelopment of the Little Commercial Street Streetscape in Korumburra.

Now that it has been endorsed by Council, the Proposed 2021/22 Council Budget and Proposed 2021/22 to 2030/31 Financial Plan are out for community feedback.
