NAME THE HUB - KORUMBURRA

Voting Now Open

South Gippsland Shire Council is proposing to officially name the new Community Hub in Korumburra. Registering a unique name with



the Geographic Names Victoria helps to ensure emergency services and the general public can locate

The new Community Hub – once constructed – will be located behind the shop precinct in Little Commercial Street, Korumburra.

A public submission period was held in March 2021 calling for name suggestions from the wider community for the new community Hub. The shortlisted names were chosen with assistance from the Korumburra Round Table and Korumburra and District Historical Society.

The shortlisted names are:

- Korumburra Community Hub
- Korumburra & District Community Hub
- Korumburra Community Centre; and
- Korumburra Hub

A voting poll is now open. All votes will be counted and the name with the majority of votes will become the official name of the new Community Hub, subject to South Gippsland Shire Council and Geographic Names Victoria approval.
