

Revised Leasing Policy Adopted

South Gippsland Shire Council adopted the revised Leasing Policy at its meeting this afternoon.

The Leasing Policy provides transparent, consistent and impartial processes when leasing Council owned and managed buildings or land. The updated policy is also expected to provide new opportunities for multiple users of facilities and allow for better use of community assets.

The policy review was delayed to allow for the consideration of the *Local Government Act 2020*, Council becoming the Committee of Management for the Great Southern Rail Trail, a review of Council's leasing portfolio and staff responsibilities in relation to leasing matters.

As of 1 July 2021, Council will have a portfolio of 110 leases and licences which comprises of 11 commercial type leases and 99 community leases.
