

Capital Works Policy Adopted

South Gippsland Shire Council adopted the new Capital Works Policy at its meeting this afternoon.

The policy is a Council Plan initiative for 2020/21 and was recommended by an internal audit to implement an evaluation criteria/policy for the selection of capital and major works projects.

The aim of the policy is to provide guidance in the planning and development of Council's Capital Works Program with an increased strategic focus and greater transparency. It outlines the necessary steps to ensure that each project is properly considered against other projects prior to being included in the program.

The policy will also provide the community with a transparent process regarding the worthiness of projects and timelines of projects.

The Community Infrastructure Advisory Committee (CIAC) that was appointed on 17 March 2021 with a broad range of demographics, interests and knowledge within the community have reviewed and endorsed the now adopted policy.
