

Vote for your preferred name

Voting is now open for the name of the new community facility that will soon be built in Korumburra. The building will be a new home for the Korumburra Library and a number of local community groups. A unique name for the building is needed to help ensure emergency services and the general public can locate the facility easily.

A public submission period was held in March, calling for name suggestions. Four names were then shortlisted with assistance from the Korumburra Round Table and Korumburra and District Historical Society.

The shortlisted names are:

- Korumburra Community Hub
- Korumburra & District Community Hub
- Korumburra Community Centre
- Korumburra Hub

Voting closes 2 July. Only one vote per person will be accepted.
