

Community Leadership Program participants finalised

South Gippsland Shire Council at its meeting on Wednesday 23 June endorsed the candidates for the second round of the Community Leadership Program.

The program, which had its first intake last year, aims to equip participants with a set of skills to work effectively with others, strengthen their leadership capability, manage conflict, delegate and meet objectives. It is hoped that participants will use the skills they gain through the program to positively influence and support the development of local communities across South Gippsland.

Applications to the South Gippsland Community Leadership Program opened in April 2021 and closed mid-May 2021. There was a total of 24 applications received by Council, with 20 participants approved to participate.

Now that the applicants have been approved, each individual will be contacted to confirm their availability to attend the sessions that begin in July. The names of the candidates will be made public once their participation is confirmed.
