### 2021/22 Council Budget Adopted

This week's Council Meeting was short but exciting with a number of important financial documents coming before Administrators.

The 2021/22 Council Budget, 2021/22 - 2030/31 Financial Plan and 2020 - 2024 Council Plan – June 2021 were all adopted unanimously.

Despite the challenges that have impacted our area over the past 12 months, the 2021/22 Budget was able to be delivered with current services maintained and without the need to apply for an exemption for the rate cap.

The creation of the Budget documents is never a quick process. It takes months of preparation and feedback both inside and outside of Council.

We would like to thank all those community members who took the time to complete a submission either in writing and in person at our virtual Council Meeting on 2 June. These were imperative to making sure we were reflecting the thoughts of our community.
