Starting Soon: McCartins Road Landslip Repairs

McCartins Road in Turtons Creek was one of the many roads impacted by the monster storm a month ago.

Now, thanks to funding announced by South Gippsland Shire Council on Wednesday, the road repairs will be expedited and begin soon.

The landslip has resulted in restricted road access for local residents, making it difficult for them to travel to get essentials.

Some work has begun already to make the road safer to use, with some new surface material being laid where the

slip took away one lane of the road, but more extensive work to repair the slip will be started soon.

The repair of other storm-affected infrastructure is also expected to be underway soon, but will likely take many months to complete due to the number of roads needing attention and the extent of the damage.
