Community Grants Round Two Open

Applications for Round Two of South Gippsland Shire Council's Community Grants Program opened on Friday 20 August.

The Community Grants Program was designed to support community initiatives that enhance the quality of life, heritage, recreation and cultural opportunities for South Gippsland residents.

Grants are available in the following categories:

- Minor Projects and Equipment Grant (up to \$5,000)
- Major Projects and Equipment Grant (up to \$10,000)
- Festival and Events Grant (up to \$10,000)
- Planning and Development Reports (up to \$10,000)

Minor Project and Equipment Grants help to assist community groups with capital work projects, the purchase of equipment or the costs associated with adopting a new or improved service. Festival and Event Grants help to support locally run community events and Planning and Development Reports can help local groups to produce a business case or evidence of viability for community-based projects or facilities.
